

## Demographic Profile Sewickley Public Library

**Population Growth:** The total population of the Sewickley Public Library service area increased by 4.2 percent over the past decade to 13,934; this growth rate was higher than the statewide rate of 3.4 percent.

**Age and Sex:** In 2010, the Sewickley Public Library service area had a total population of 13,934 - 6,467 males (46.4 percent) and 7,467 females (53.6 percent). The age structure of the population in 2010 was as follows: 24.7 percent of the population was under 20 years old, 53.2 percent was 20 to 64 years old and 22.1 percent was 65 years or older.

**Race and Ethnicity:** For people reporting one race alone, not of Hispanic ethnicity, 91.6 percent were White; 3.8 percent were Black or African American; 3.0 percent were Other Race Alone.<sup>1</sup> A total of 222 or 1.6 percent of the population were Hispanic.<sup>2</sup>

**Households:** In 2010, there were 6,027 households in the Sewickley Public Library service area. The average household size was 2.29 people. Families made up 62.3 percent of the households. This figure includes both families with (26.6 percent) and without (35.7 percent) children. Of families with children less than 18 years old, 20.7 percent were married-couple families, 4.6 percent were female householder families with no husband present, and the remaining (1.3 percent) were male-headed households with no wife present.

**Education:** The educational attainment of the population 25 years and over was higher in the Sewickley Public Library service area than in Pennsylvania. During the period 2008-2012, 52.8 percent of residents had earned a Bachelor's degree or higher, compared with 27.0 percent statewide. A total of 460 or 4.6 percent had not completed high school, compared with 11.7 percent for the commonwealth as a whole.

**Income and Poverty:** Households with incomes of \$100,000 or More (35.6 percent) made up the largest percent of households in the Sewickley Public Library service area in 2008-2012. For comparison, 20.8 percent of commonwealth households were in this range during the period.

In 2008-2012, the overall poverty rate for the Sewickley Public Library service area was lower than Pennsylvania (4.4 percent compared to 13.1 percent). The poverty rate for the population under 18 years of age was 4.7 percent, compared with 4.0 percent of people 18 to 64 years and 5.0 percent for those aged 65 years and over. A total of 81 or 2.2 percent of all families had incomes below poverty level. In 2008-2012, 3.4 percent of families with related children and 16.5 percent of families with a female householder and no husband with related children present had incomes below the poverty level.

**Class of Worker and Occupation:** In 2008-2012, 84.9 percent of the workforce was private wage and salary workers; 8.3 percent were federal, state, or local government workers; and 6.5 percent were self-employed in their own (not incorporated) business.

The top occupation group for the civilian employed population 16 years and over in the Sewickley Public Library service area in 2008-2012 was Management, business, science, and arts (52.6 percent).

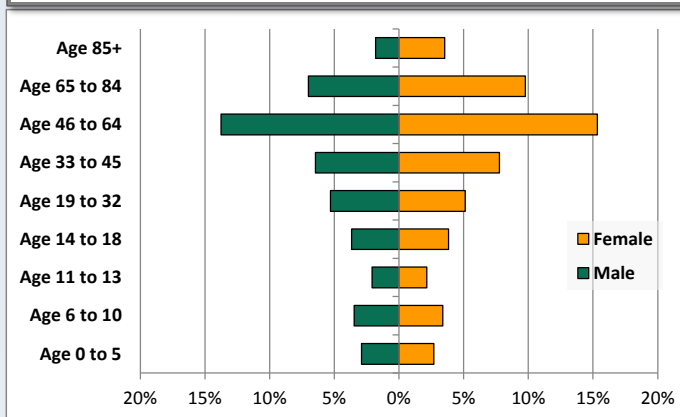

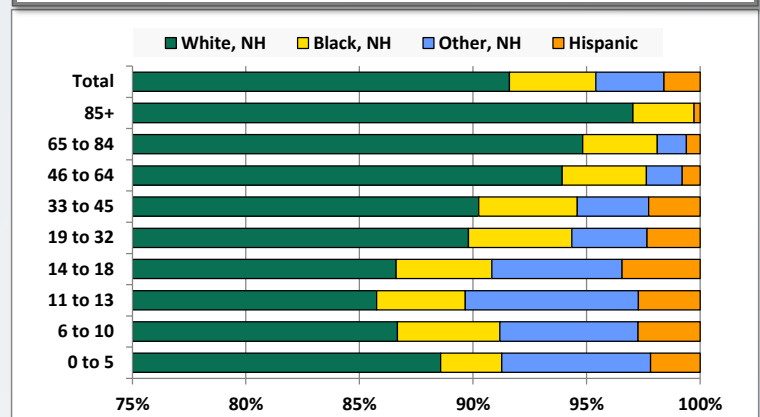

Population by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010



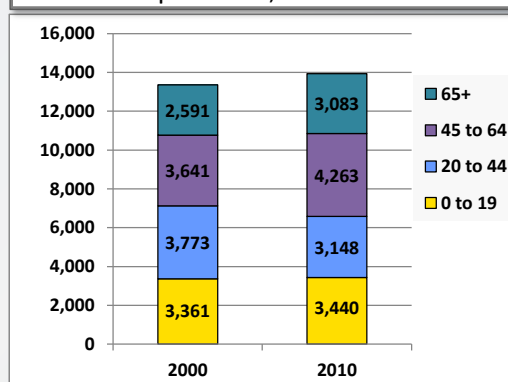
Race/Ethnicity by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010

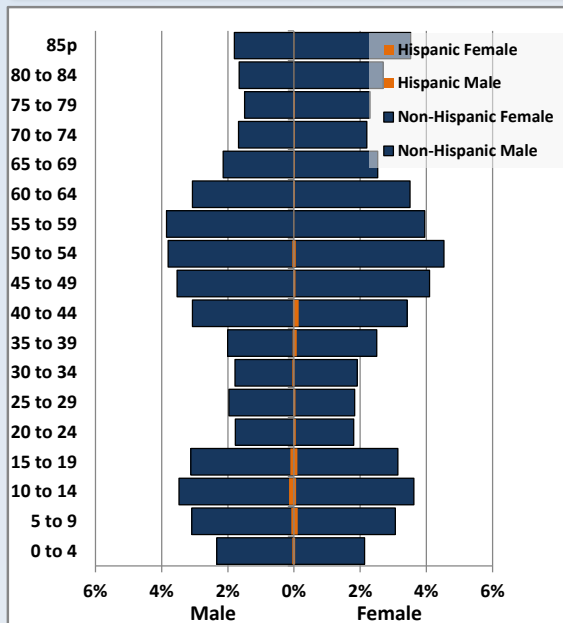

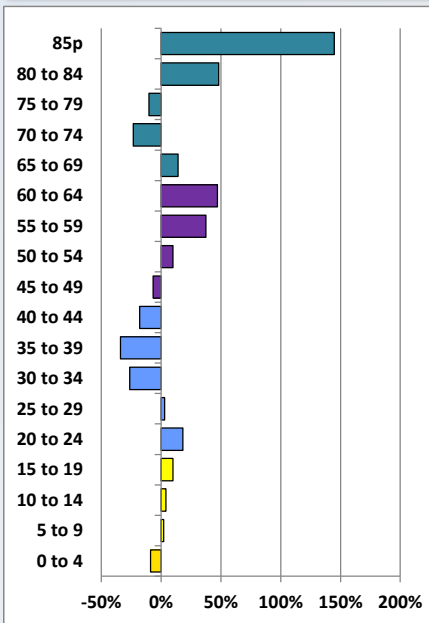

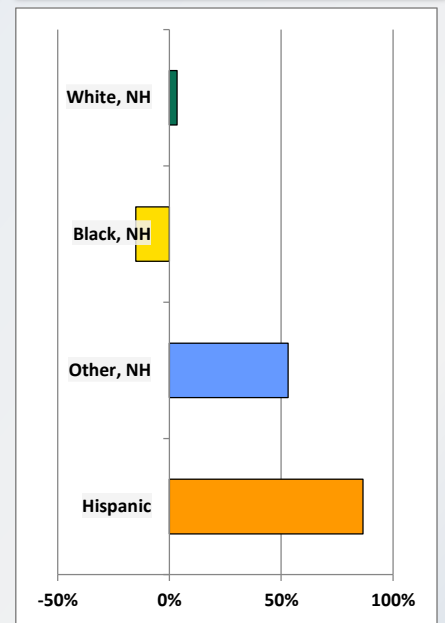
Population by 5-Year Age Cohorts



Pop Change by Age, 2000 to 2010

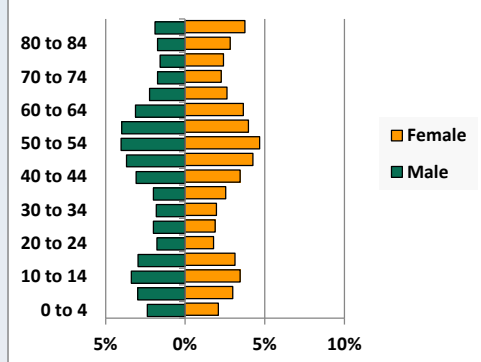


Pop Change by Race/Ethnicity, 2000 to 2010

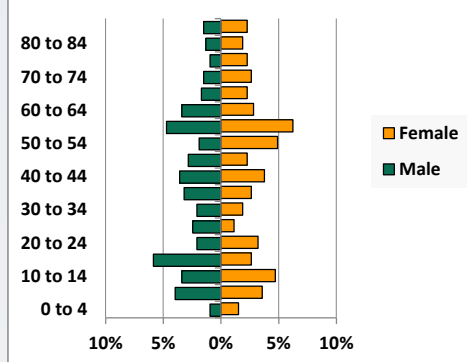


Population by Age, Race and Ethnicity 2010

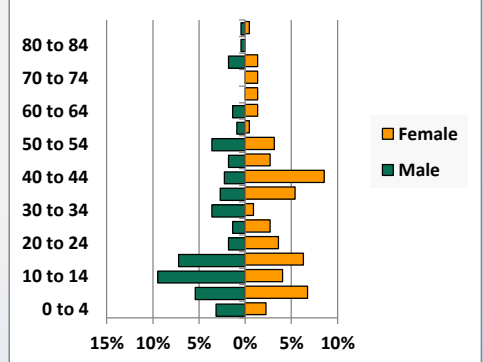

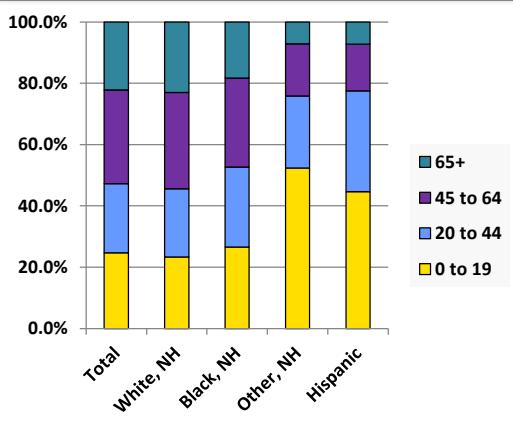

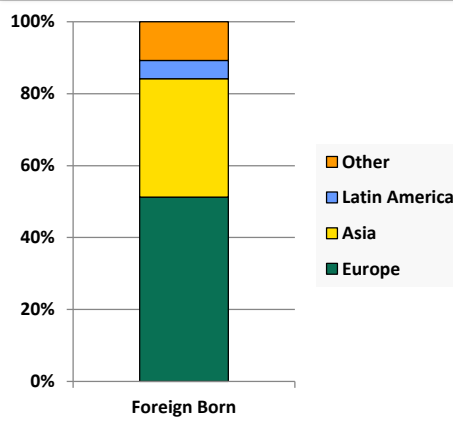

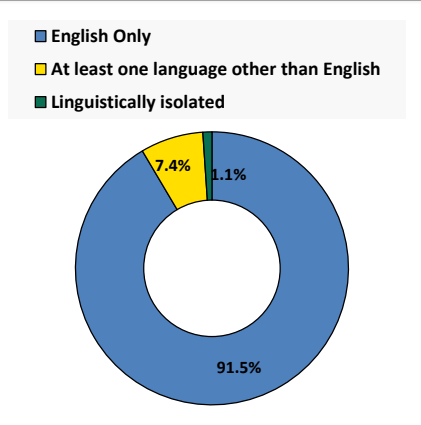
Age by Race and Ethnicity, 2010



Foreign Born, 2010



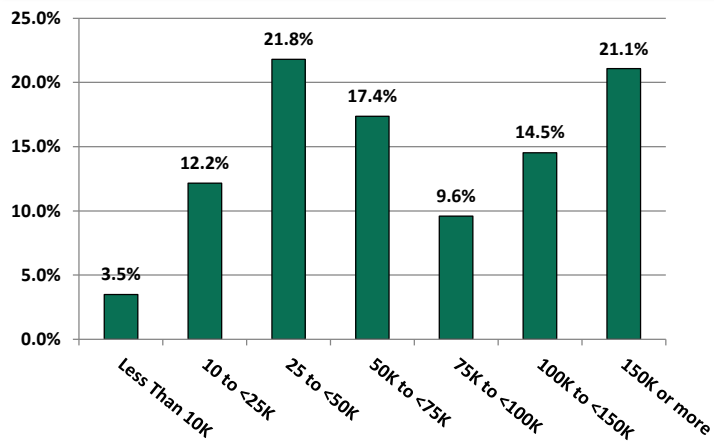

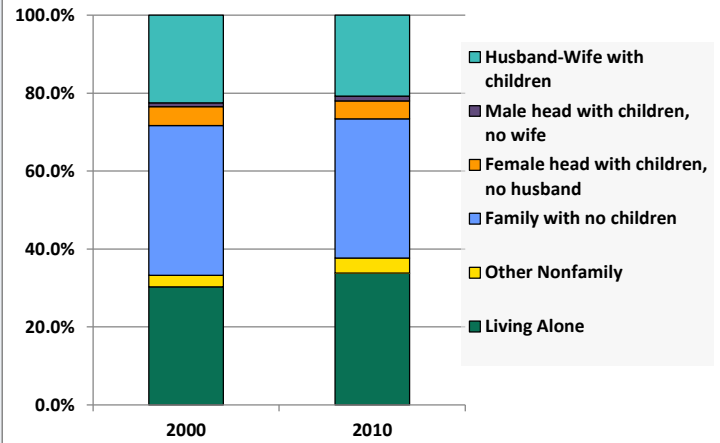
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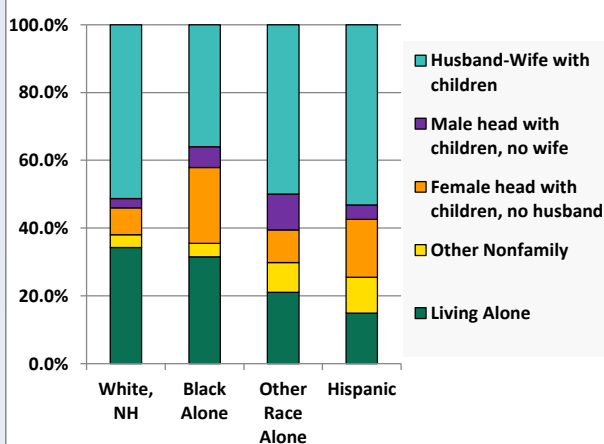
Household Income Distribution, 2008-2012



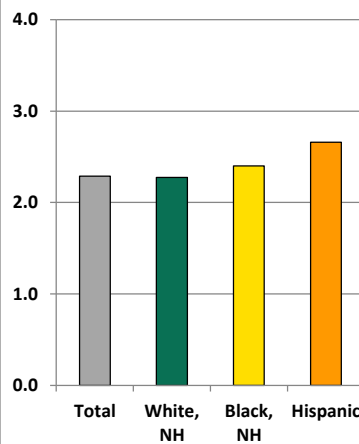
Household Type, 2000 and 2010



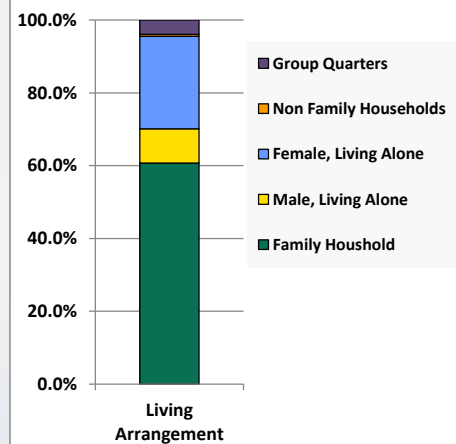
Household Type by Race/Ethnicity, 2010



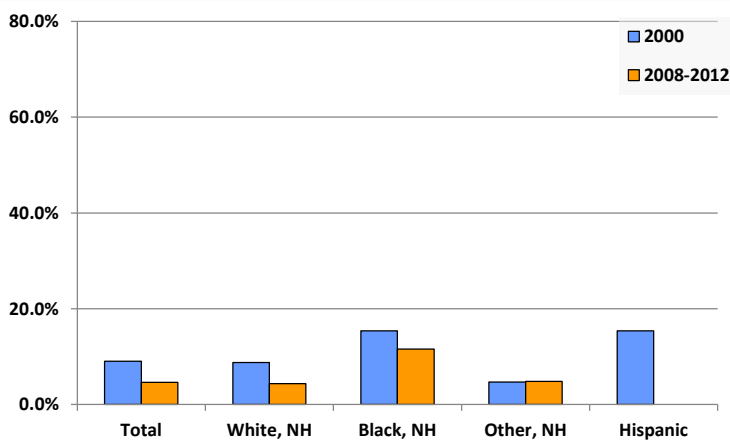
Average Household Size, 2010



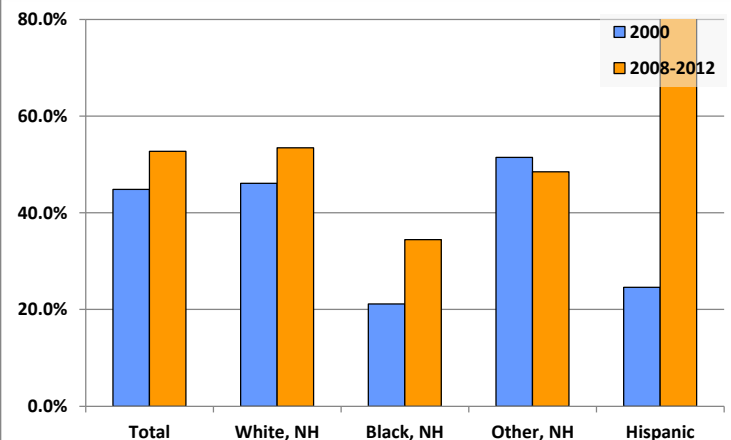
Living Arrangements 65+, 2008-2012
